



DIY oil lamp

When it gets cold and uncomfortable outside, it's time to get cosy inside. With a cosy blanket, cocoa and a few homemade oil lamps, the home becomes a place of well-being in no time at all.

To make the oil lamp, you will need the following things:

- 1. A bottle with an aluminium lid (100 ml bottles are suitable)
- 2. A standard DIY luminaire mounting set (80 mm threaded tube M 10, nuts M 10)
 - 3. One wick, 8 mm for oil lamps (e.g. wicks for bamboo torches)
 - 4. Lamp oil
 - 5. Pliers
 - 6. Cordless screwdriver with 12 mm metal drill
 - 7. Drilling pad

Recommendation: Use protective work gloves so that the lid does not slip out of your hands and you do not cut yourself on the edges.

Instruction:

Remove the label from the bottle and clean the bottle.

Remove all plastic parts of the bottle and the lid with the pliers. Drill a hole in the centre of the lid with the metal drill.

Screw a nut onto the threaded tube. Screw the wick into the threaded tube until it protrudes about 3 mm on the other side.

Insert the threaded tube into the hole of the bottle cap and mount the second nut. Fill the bottle with lamp oil and screw the lid with wick on the bottle.

Before lighting, wait until the wick is completely soaked with oil.
